

**RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SECTION
“GOOD GOVERNANCE, RULE OF LAW
AND COMBATING CORRUPTION”**

Realization and protection of human rights, quality of their life, dynamics of economic development, environmental situation & other priorities of a modern democratic State are primarily dependant on functioning of public administration, legislative and judicial institutions. Just only effective government machinery is capable to recognize and address the social problems, provide proper conditions for realization of human rights and freedoms. Inefficient governance is the main reason of depressive development in all spheres of state- and social life (medical care, education, economics etc.), that makes impossible their further reform and development.

Participants of the section have come to the conclusion, that it is necessary to implement and improve the following forms of co-operation with the European Union with the purpose to improve efficiency of the reforms, oriented on public management quality improvement:

1. To provide political pressure on the government bodies of the Eastern Partnership region for implementation of democracy principles, standards of good governance, rule of law and mechanisms of combating corruption.
2. To support activities of the civil society institutions, that fruitfully co-operate in the sphere of monitoring of public authorities activities, implementation of reforms, primarily, analytical centers, youth NGO, business associations.
3. To strengthen efficiency of expert support to the undertaken reforms in the region of Eastern Partnership, first of all, through professional and adequate expertise of the policy and legal drafting.
4. To develop & implement efficient mechanisms of reform in the sphere of education in the countries of the Eastern Partnership region, mainly in the sphere of law and public management.
5. To define in the official acts the perspective of EU-partnership for the countries of the Eastern Partnership, that are willing to it, having marked the essential standards, being significant condition for the accession.
6. To provide support to realization of Twinning and TAEX programs in the countries of Eastern Partnership.
7. To involve independent civil society institutions participation for evaluation of the implemented projects, supported by the European Commission and governments of the EU-member states, in the Eastern Partnership region.
